YOUR MATERIALS LIST

We will be making a layered textile collage, using recycled and newer materials. Remember you are translating your vision into cloth, so the representations of doors, windows, architectural details don't have to be photographic, more interpretive.

Please bring the following items with you to class:

- Printing blocks or rubber stamps that fit with the theme, a small quantity of fabric paint or acrylic paint, and a sponge (not natural)
- Sewing machine (if desired) and machine cotton
- Hand stitching kit with embroidery cotton
- Thin layering fabrics (lace, organza, old net curtains)
- Stronger fabric for an A3 maximum background (linen, heavy cotton)
- Scraps of fabric for house/garden shapes in desired colours and patterns
- Pritt stick, pins
- Ribbon or scraps of embroidery from old table linen, buttons
- Paper and pencil, tracing or greaseproof paper
- Scalpel
- Cutting board
- Choose pictures of your house and/or garden and collect some images of them and print them out if possible

Have a look through your 'stash' and choose the best, most inspiring pieces to bring with you. Pre-selection helps greatly and means you are working with elements that you love – and will use on your piece of work.
