



'Exploring white in textile & stitch' with Caroline Zoob **2 days: 25th-26th August 2022**

YOUR MATERIALS LIST

Caroline will bring many of the materials you need, as listed below.

The cost is £25. Please bring your payment to class in cash in an envelope with your name clearly written on the front. Hand your envelope to Lynne or Jenny when you arrive.

- A bundle of assorted linen pieces for each participant.
- Lace, trims, broderies, decoratives and other materials in a neutral palette (these will be laid out and are to be shared on a first spot, first use basis, with participants replacing what they do not use)
- Other vintage fabrics in neutral colours, as above
- White gouache paint and gesso
- Embroidery threads in neutral colours, plenty for everyone
- Templates for shapes; tracings for transfers
- Assorted cotton threads for machines
- Assorted vintage threads for hand stitching and couching
- Drawing and tracing paper
- Inspiration and handout literature

Please also bring the following items with you to class:

- Notebook and pen/pencil/eraser
- Frixion pen (black, fine tip if possible)
- Own workbox/sewing kit with sharp embroidery scissors and embroidery needles (size 8-10) and own embroidery hoop, if you have one
- A tin of pins
- Apron

- ❑ Any sketches/images/ideas from your notebooks – but don't worry if you do not have these, Caroline will have plenty with her, including some designs printed onto linen for you to use.
- ❑ Optional – there will be plenty available within the materials cost – any small pieces of fabric/haberdashery/lace you have collected and may want to use: things such as small buttons, scraps of lace or trim
- ❑ Sewing machine, if you have one and like using one. Please ensure you know how to use your machine. If you bring a machine, please also bring some COATS 100% cotton ivory and white threads. A machine is helpful if you decide to piece a base.
